Report of Public Safety:

Ms. Williams also said she received a complaint about city taxes and assessments and asked if we had a certified assessor. The Solicitor said that we go by the third class city code and he will investigate the matter.

Report of Parks & Property:

Councilman Polonoli asked that a letter be drafted to the Adult Probation Office in Washington informing them that as of January 1, 2019 probation services will no longer be permitted to use the Monongahela Police Station for any services. A letter will also be sent to Big's Sanitation to inform them about picking up all garbage that falls off their trucks.

Councilman Williams distributed the year end report of the Aquatorium Innovations and informed council it may be a possibility that there will be no concerts this year. Councilman Kulak asked if there was a process of turning the decision around. At this time the group has to discuss it further.


