### **Public Forum**

Chad DeSantis, Decker Street, Monongahela, thanked Chief Harris for speaking with him and was grateful for him being Pro-Active in listening to suggestions, and would like to offer Council various ideas concerning their departments. Also asked about a camera system and live feed for the Municipal Meetings.

Terry Necciai, 400 Meade Street, Monongahela spoke about the Main Street Program and commended the Library on a successful bake sale, held on Election Day. He also passed around before and after pictures of successful renovation of buildings on Main Street, Third Street and Second Street. The Main Street Program and Facade Program has helped to bring economic development to the City.

He was also asked by Councilman Polonoli if he will be bringing back his Calliopica Calendar.
